Indiana Michigan Power (I&M) officials plan to upgrade the electric transmission network serving customers in eastern Muncie. The project involves upgrading about 3.5 miles of power line to increase electric reliability in the area.



WHAT

The project involves upgrading about 3.5 miles of electric transmission line to 69-kilovolt standards.

WHY

- The improvements:
- Increase electric reliability in the area
 - Reduce the likelihood of outages in the area


WHERE

- City of Muncie
- Center Township in Delaware County

Plans call for rebuilding some sections of power line in the company's existing right-of-way. Other sections may include re-routes and require new easements.


TYPICAL STRUCTURES

The project involves installing steel poles.

Structure Height: 60-90 feet*

Right-of-Way Width: Approximately 50 feet*
