The Western Fort Wayne Area Improvements Project involves:

- Building about 14 miles of new 69-kilovolt (kV) transmission line
- Upgrading approximately 11 miles of 34.5-kV transmission line to 69-kV standards
- · Upgrading several area substations
- Building the new Snapper Substation in southern Churubusco


WHY


- Strengthens the local electric transmission system
- · Reduces the likelihood of power outages
- Speeds recovery of service when outages occur
- Prepares the electric system to support economic development.

WHERE


The upgrades take place in Washington, Perry, Eel River and Lake townships in Allen County and Columbia, Union, Thorncreek and Smith townships in Whitley County.
