WHERE

The project area includes:

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- City of Wapakoneta
- Pusheta, Washington, St. Marys, Duchouquet and Moulton townships in Auglaize County

TYPICAL STRUCTURES

The proposed project will use steel, single-pole structures estimated to be about 90-feet tall. The structures will be constructed in an approximate 100-foot wide right-of-way corridor.

Structure Height: Approximately 90 feet Right-of-Way Width: Approximately 100 feet
